

There is no magic formula for success. Just 3 essential ingredients which, when combined, can work wonders.

**The desire to succeed.
The willingness to work hard.
Consistent efforts.**

THE number of vehicles on the roads is increasing every day. Two wheelers (i.e.) motor cycles, scooters and mopeds constitute 60 to 65 per cent of these vehicles. With limited road space available it is very essential that two wheeler riders should follow road rules to prevent accidents. In the alphabet of road safety rules, the letters are:

A – Always wear clothes that suit you and be alert always.

B – Both riders (the driver and the pillion rider) should wear fibre glass reinforced plastic type helmets (BIS 4151). Do not make alterations to the helmet to suit personal convenience.

C – Children should not be made to stand in front on a scooter or made to sit on the petrol tank of a motorcycle.

D – Decisions must be taken by the driver only when turning, stopping and overtaking.

E – Ensure that the clutch, brakes, tyres, tubes and lights are working.

F – Fatigue must be avoided. Sufficient rest is a must before one rides on a vehicle.

G – Go slow while



passing animals and animal drawn carts and "L" board and go, No "U" turn.

H – Hand signals must be indicated wherever necessary only by the driver.

I – Identify pot holes and unauthorised speed breakers without zebra stripes to avoid accidents.

J – Jumping signals should be avoided (i.e.) passing the signal head without getting the correct signal.

K – Know the significance of road markings (vertical and horizontal types). The important ones are the centre yellow line, the white yellow line, the broken white line for cycle tracks, the arrow for turning, the stop line, the zebra crossing.

L – Learn the language of the road (i.e.) (signs and signals). Signs:

Mandatory signs : (e.g) Halt and go, No "U" turn.

Cautionary signs : (e.g) Narrow bridge, hairpin bend, road dip.

Informatory signs : (e.g) parking place, petrol bunk, eating place.

Signals : 1. Driver's hand signals. 2. Policemen hand signals. 3. Electrical signals.

M – Make sure no pedestrian is crossing in front of or behind a stationary vehicle while passing by such a vehicle.

N – Not to get distracted by hoardings, posters.

O – Over-speeding must be avoided and overtaking must be done with caution.

P – Parking should be at right places only.

Q – Quality of spare parts must be ensured before using them. Buy genuine spare parts from an authorised dealer.



R – Road bends and curves must be negotiated carefully by slowing down.

S – Skidding must be avoided by not using bald tyres and being wary of oil spills, slush, molten tar, dry leaves.

T – Two wheeler riders shouldn't get in between two large vehicles like lorries, buses. If the vehicle in front suddenly applies brakes the rear vehicle will hit the two wheeler leading to an accident.

U – Use both brakes simultaneously

V – Vehicles should not be loaded with bulky or large materials. You would not like being toppled over.

W – Weaving is to be avoided, (i.e.) not sticking to one lane and moving between one lane and the other.

X – Xylophonic vibration in a pleasant form is comparable to the road rules observed in correct form.

Y – Yellow line is the life line or the heart line and is not to be crossed.

Z – Zebra crossing. If not controlled by electrical traffic signals or a traffic policeman, give right of way to pedestrians.
